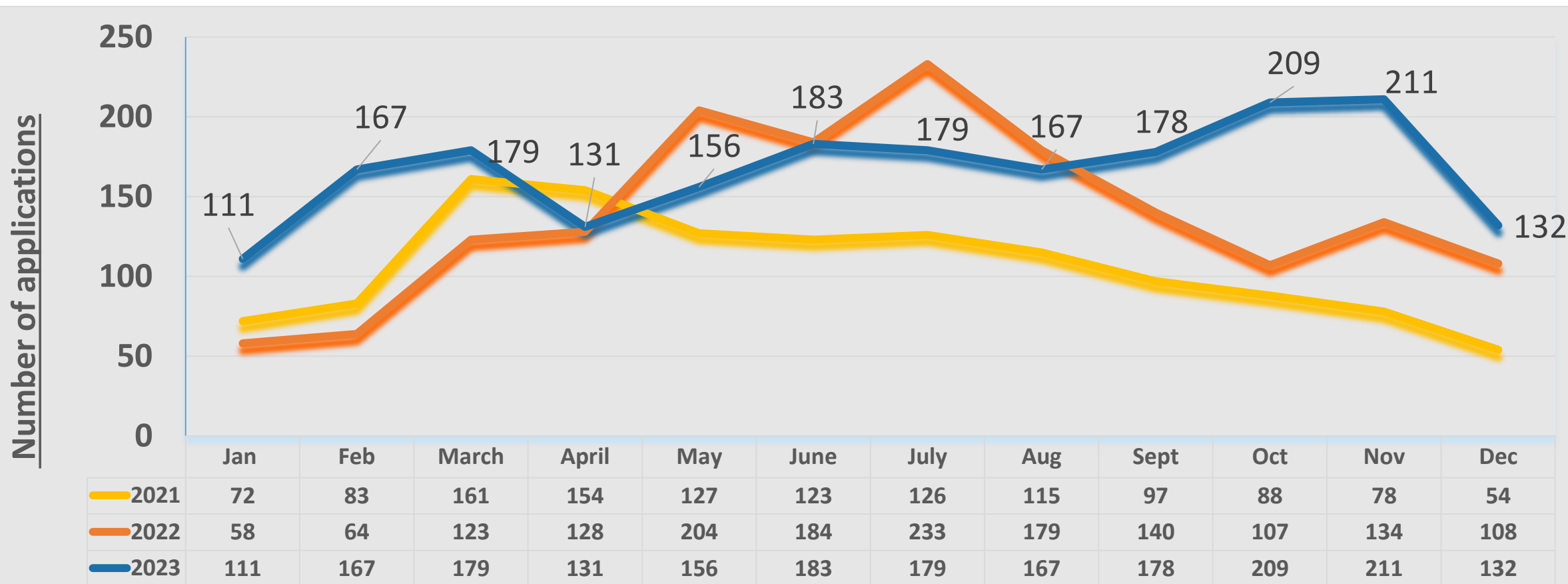

Total Number of Applications Recorded

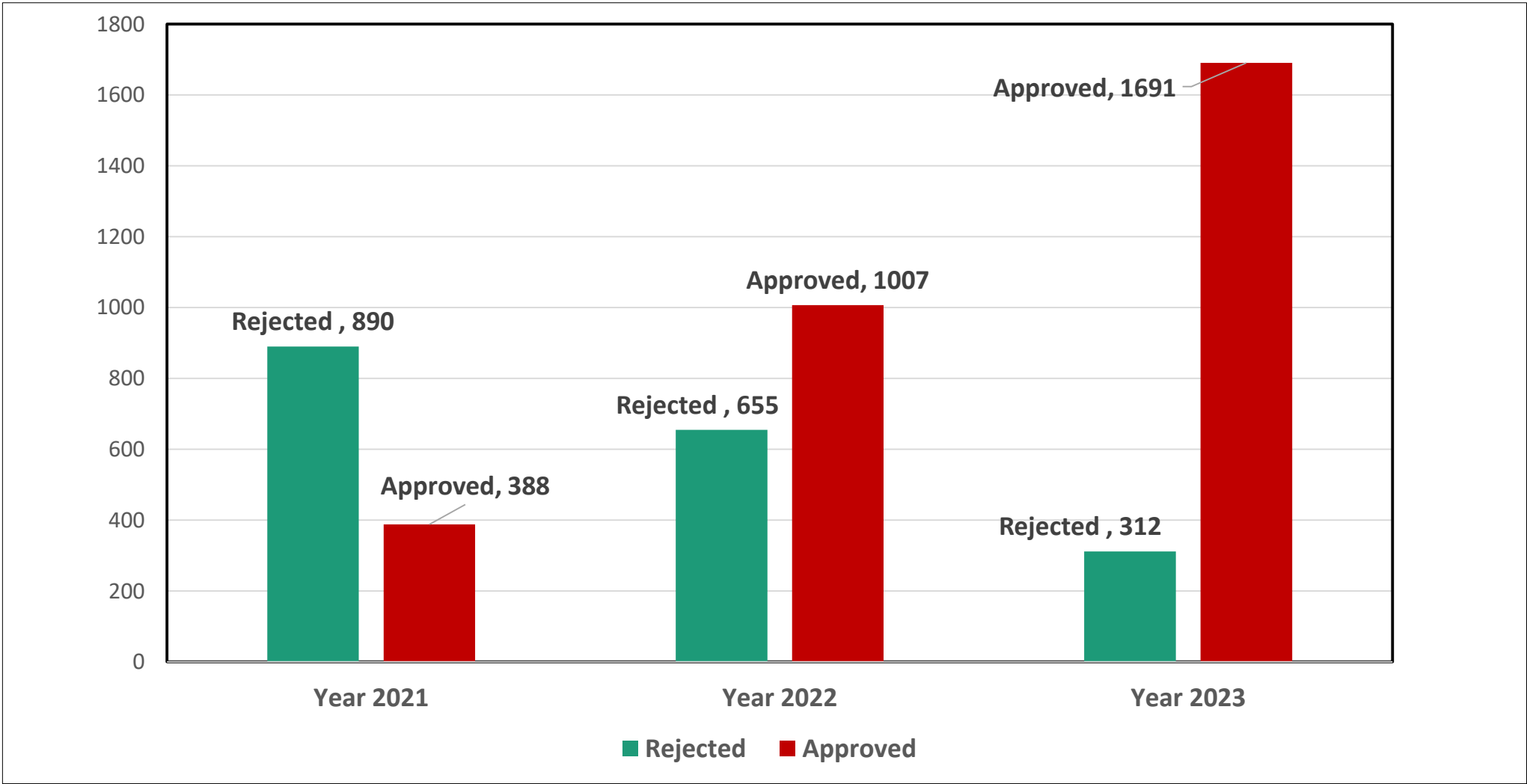
Total Welfare Application per month over Year 2021/2022/2023



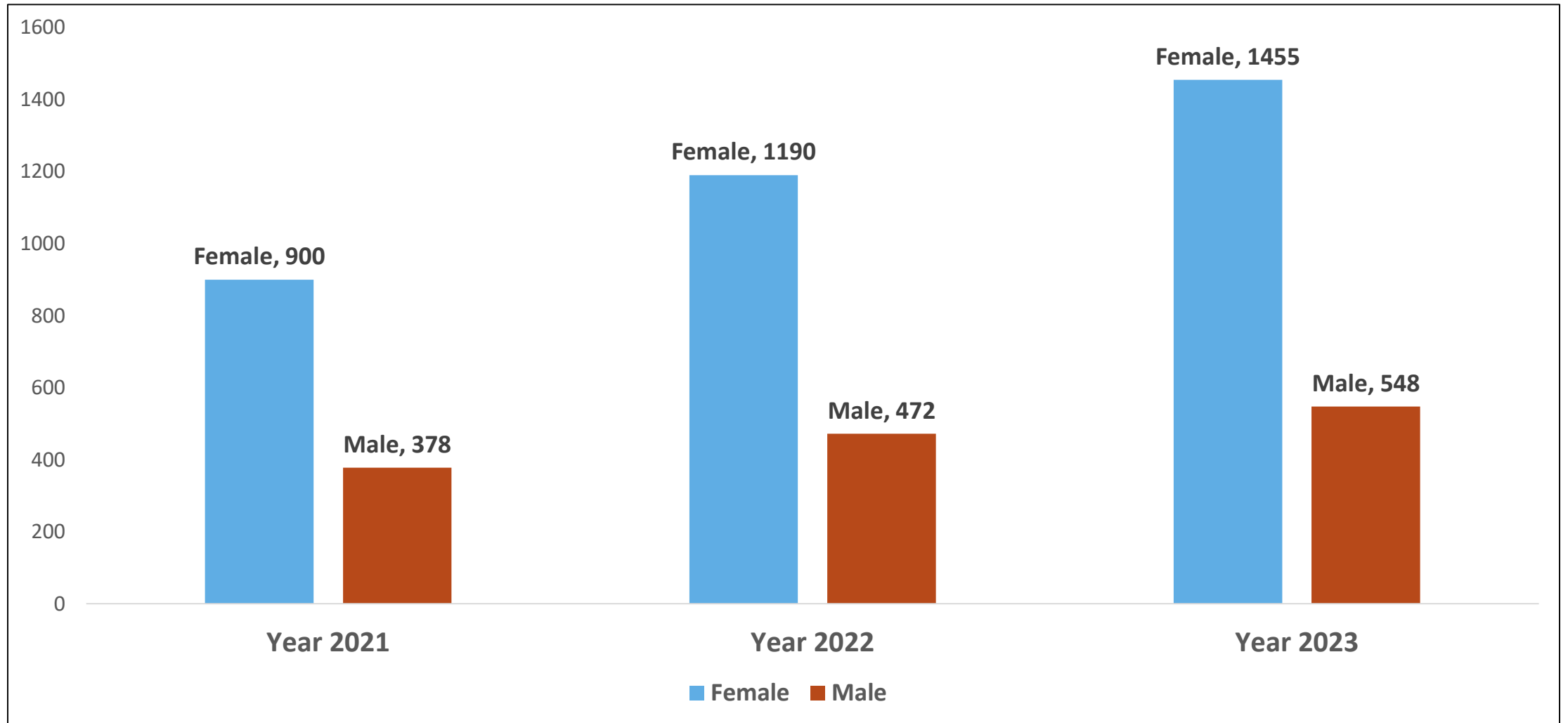

Total Overall outcome of Cases 2021/2022/2023

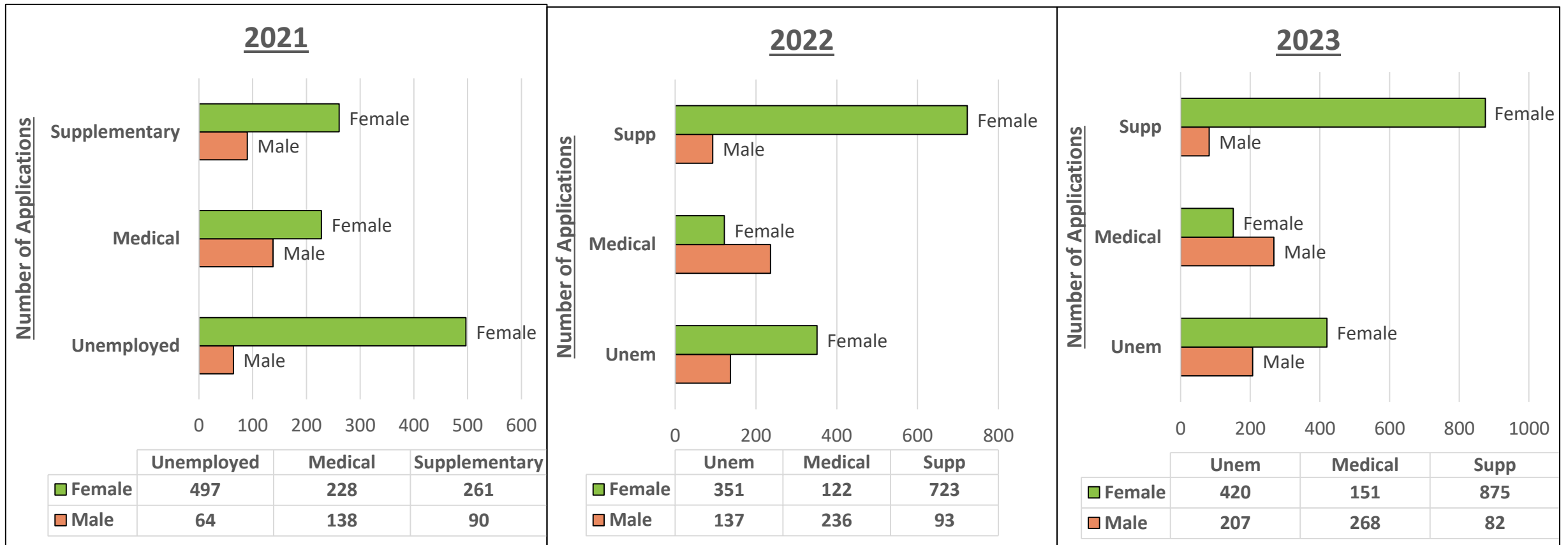


Total Gender of Applicants for all three years

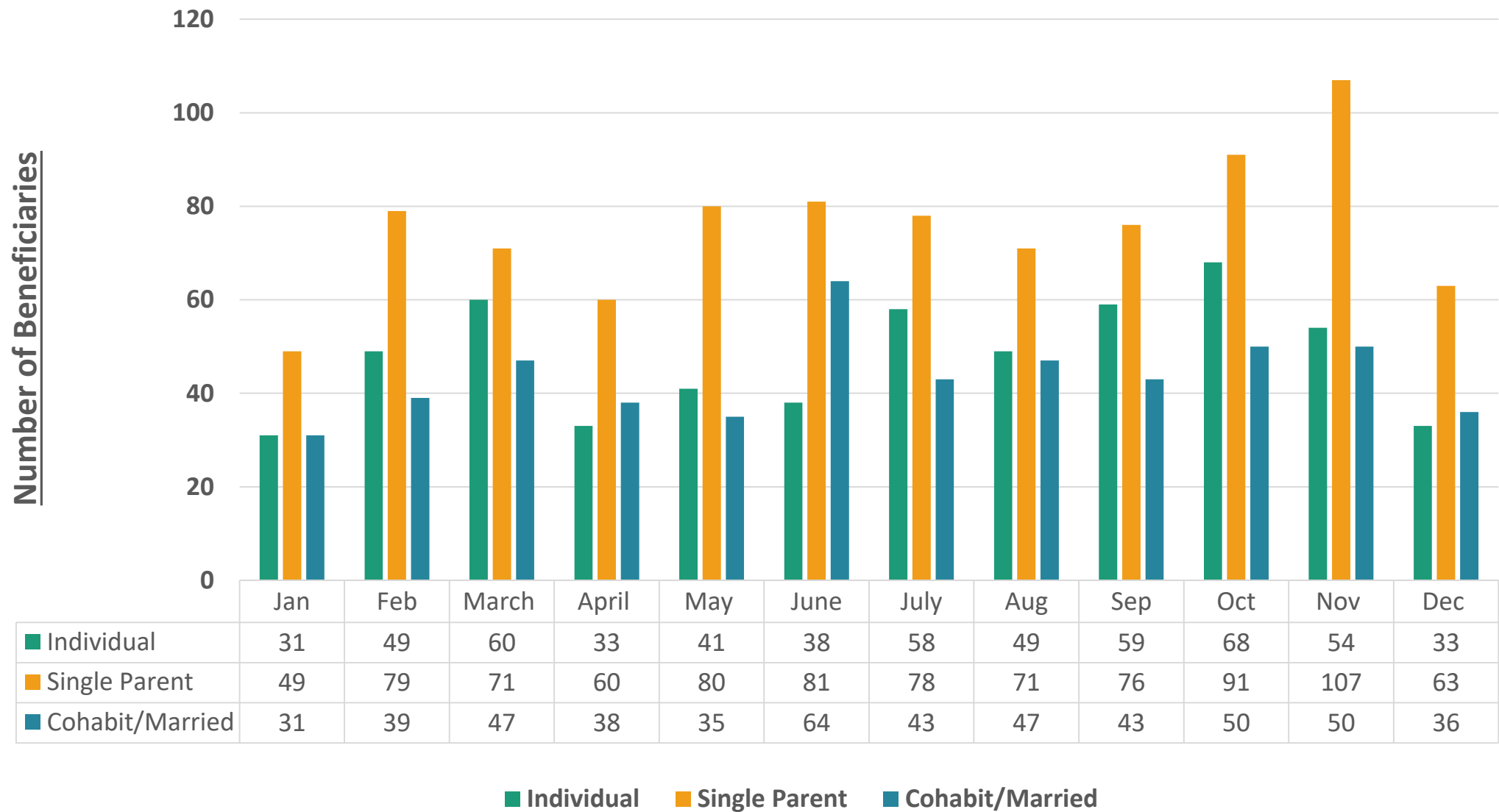


Applications per Welfare Grounds per Gender

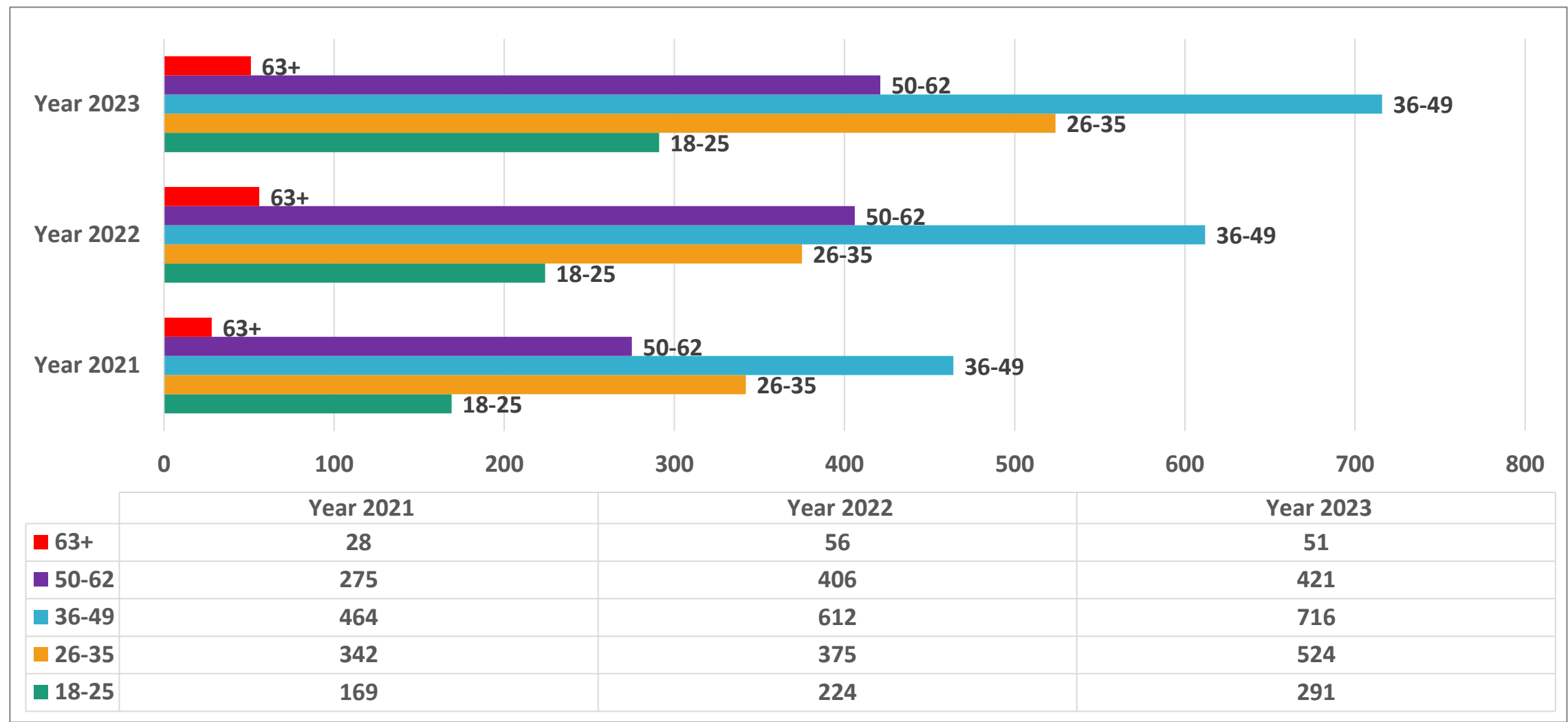
Number of Application per welfare ground per year (2021/2022/2023) per gender

Distribution of Total Applications per Age Group

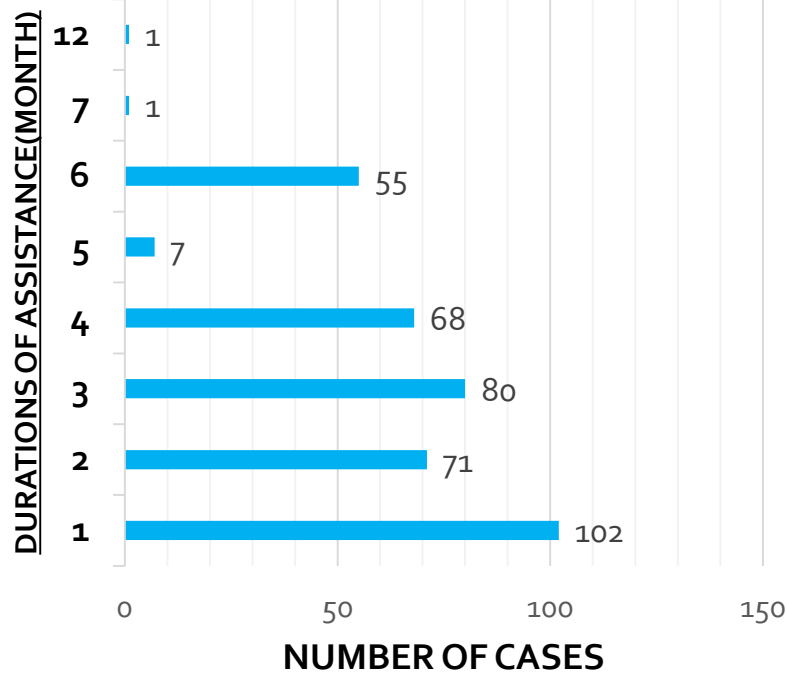

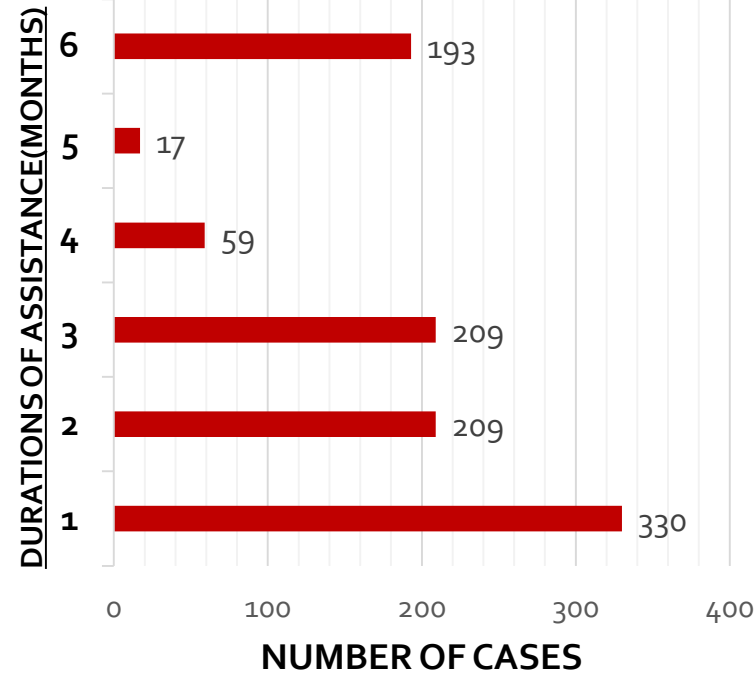

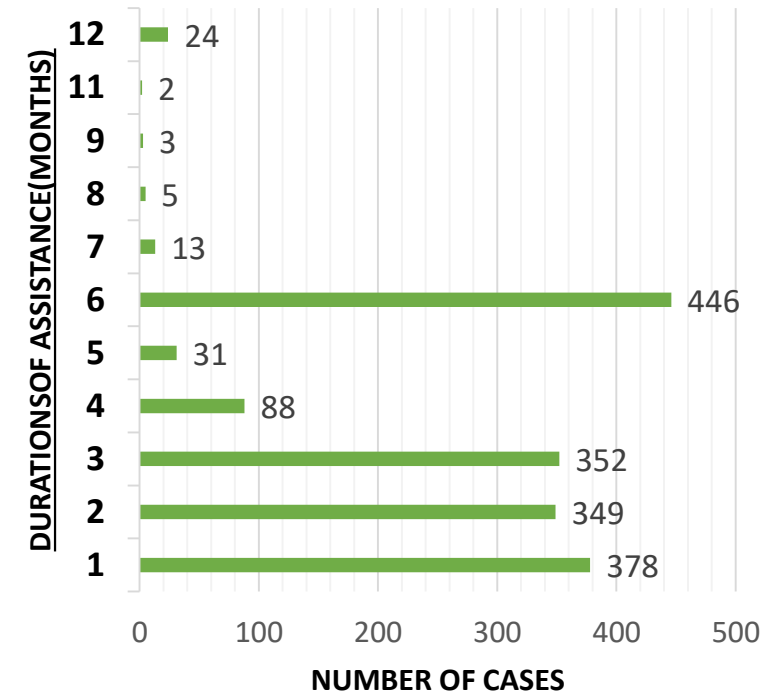

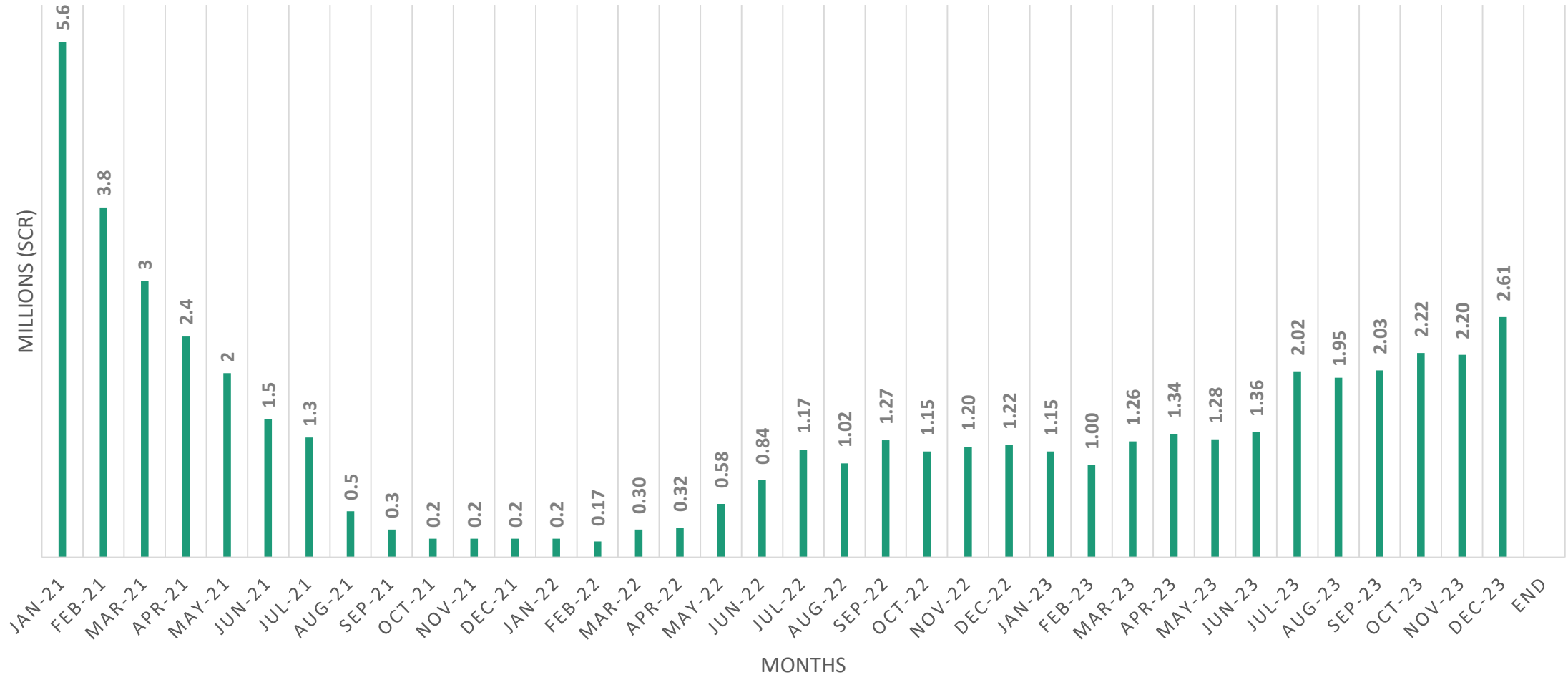

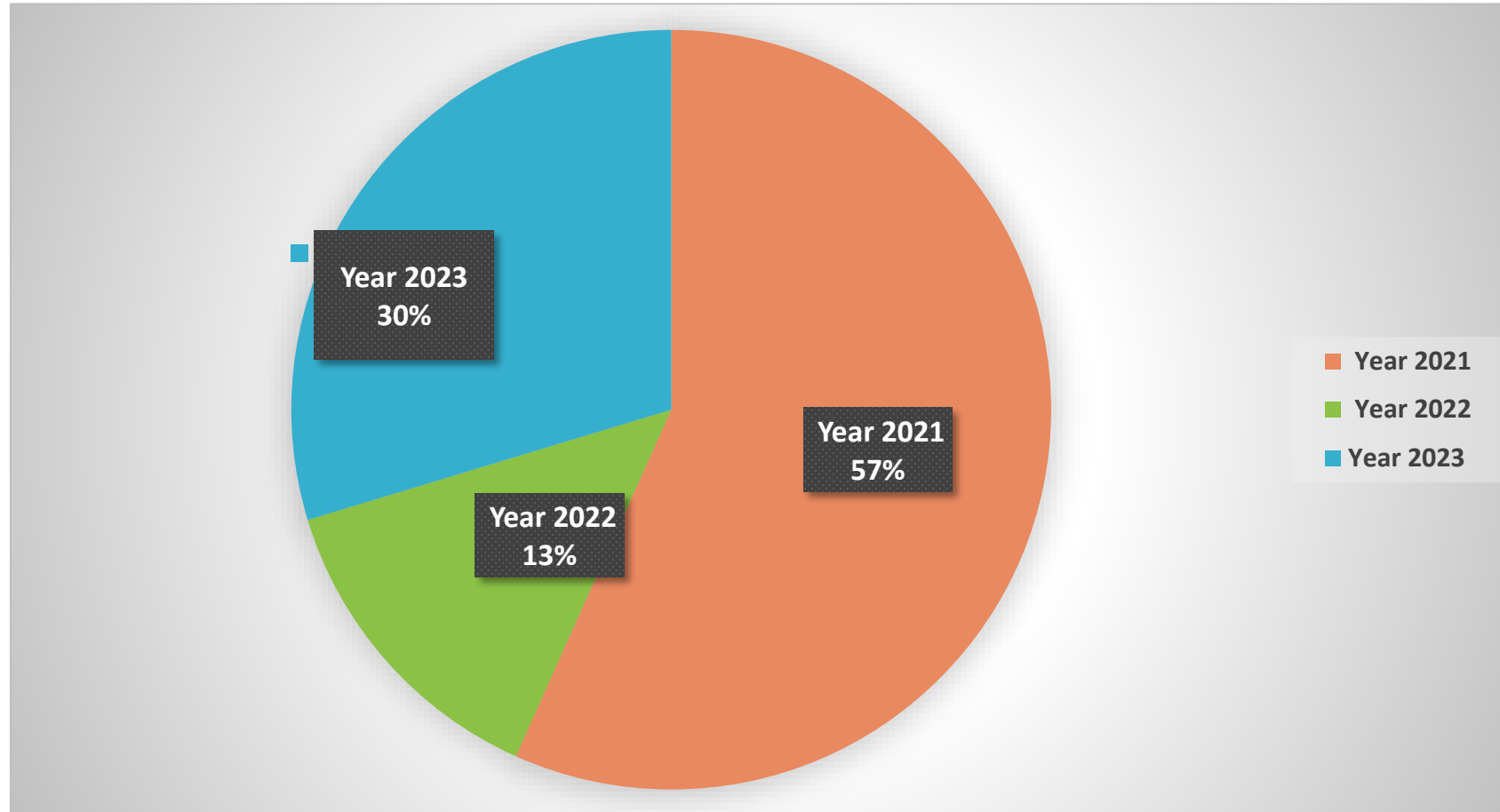

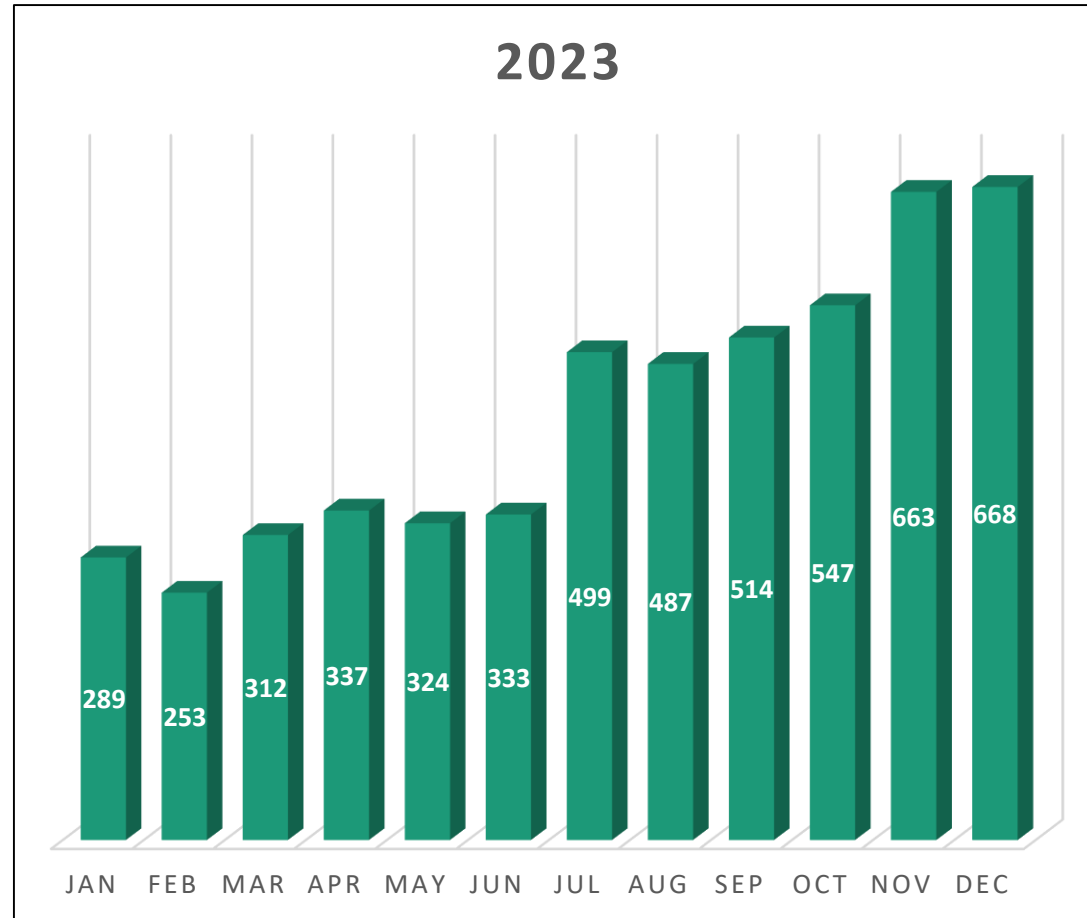
Welfare Spending 2021/2022/ 2023

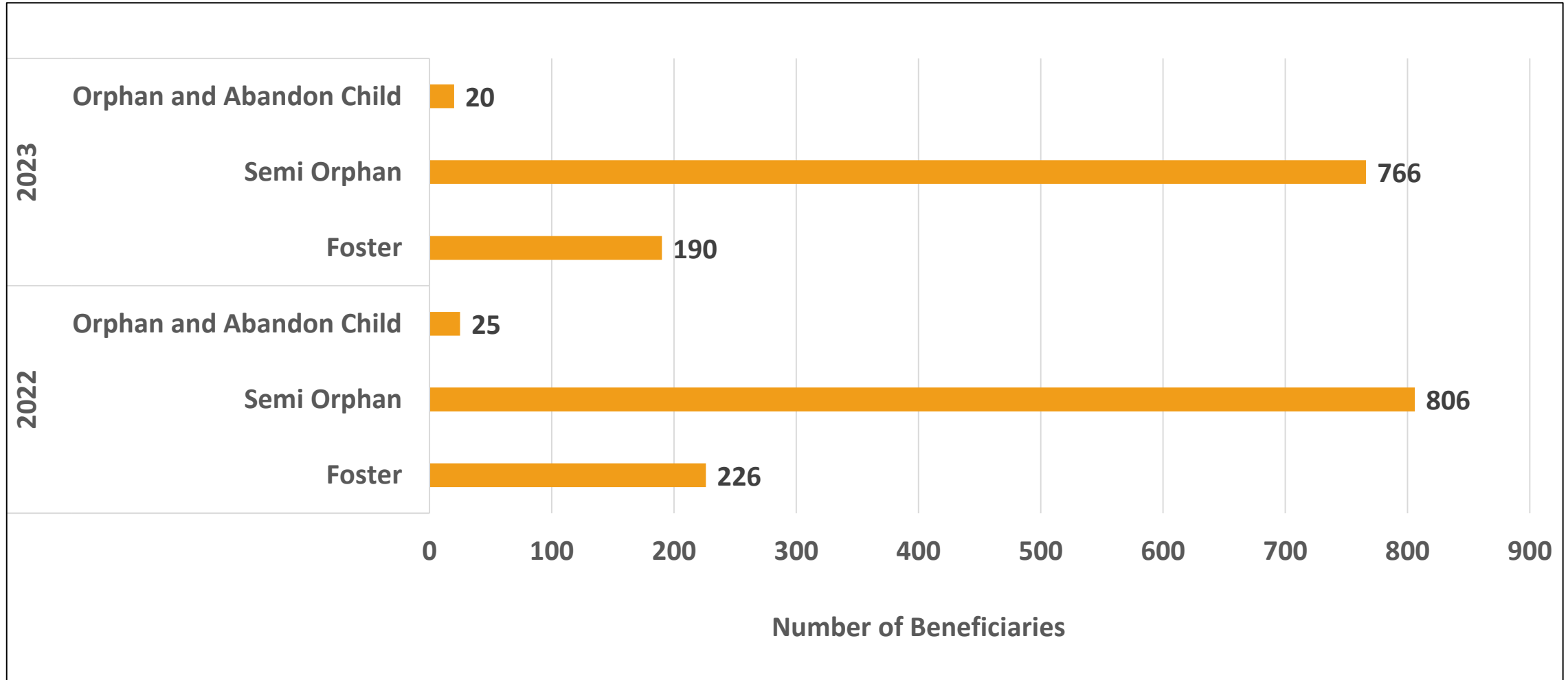

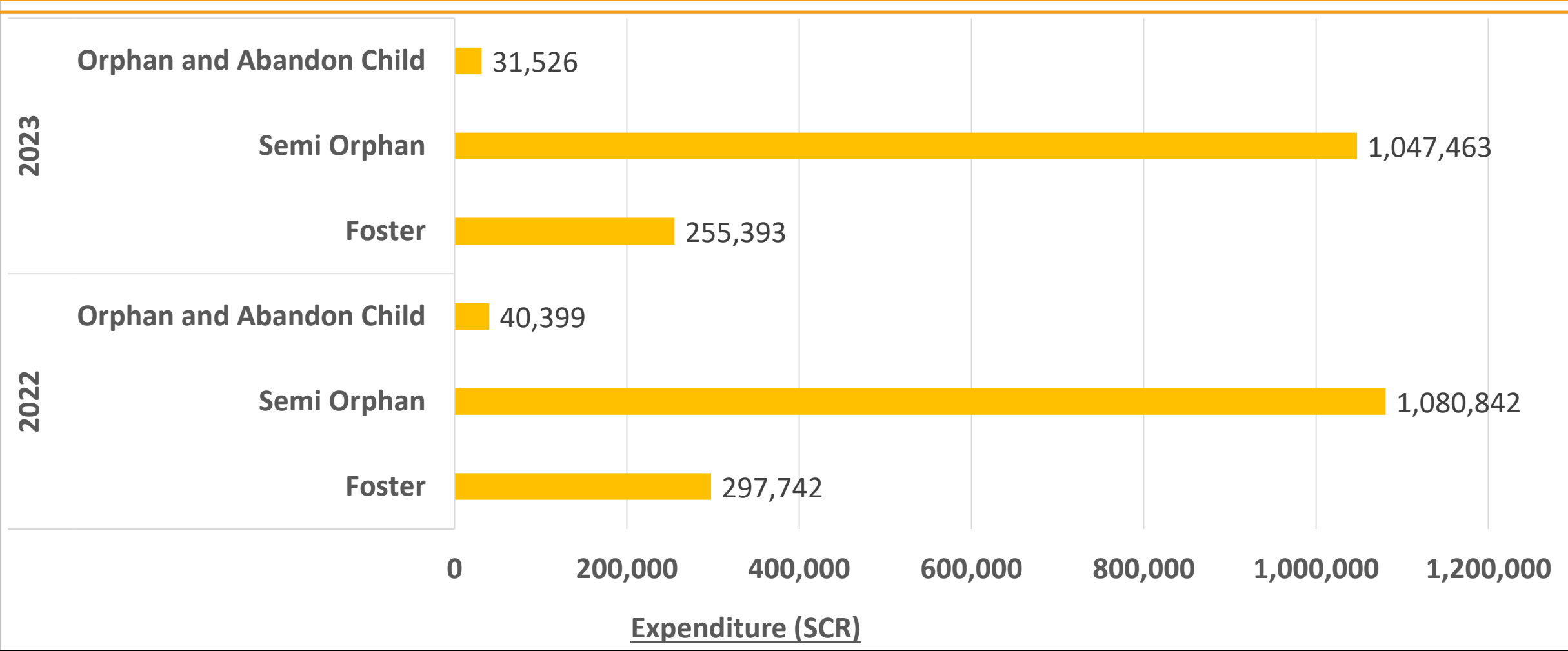

Average Number Beneficiaries for Child Care

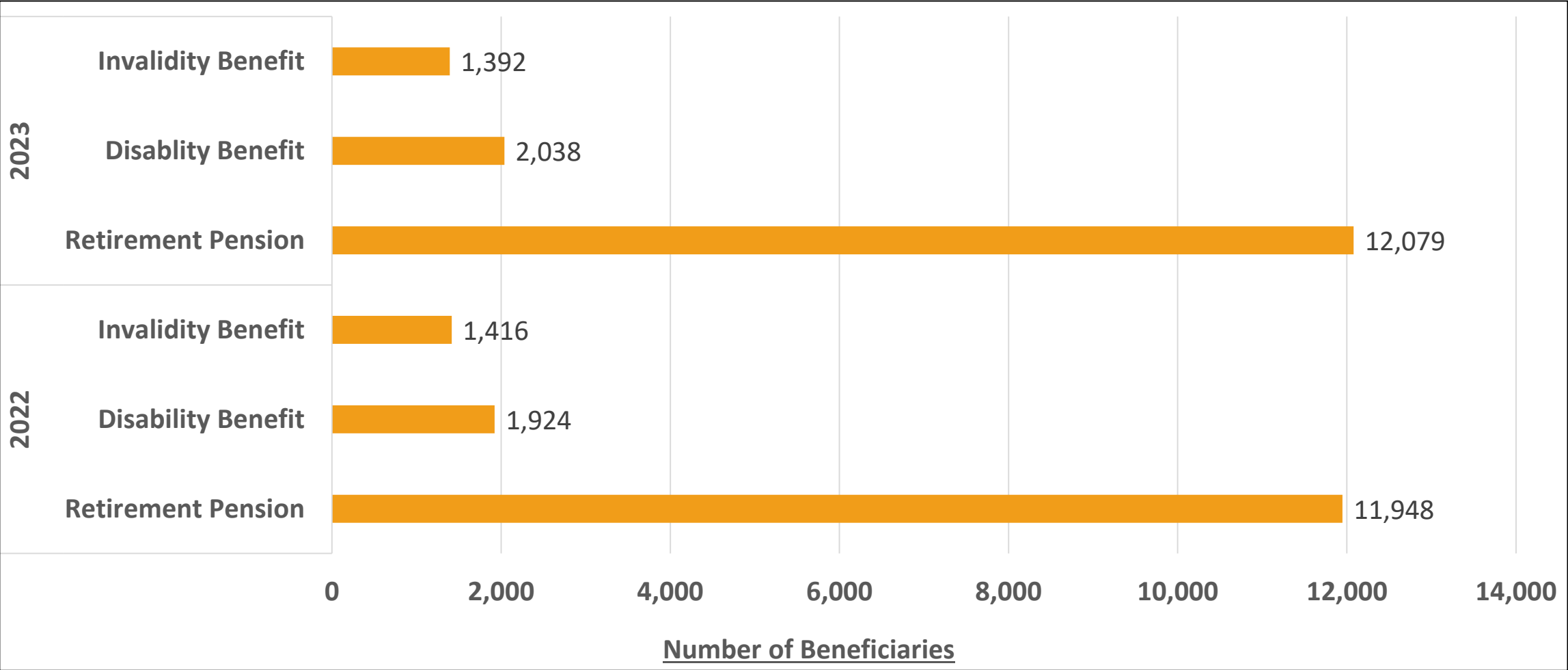


Average Spending for Child Care

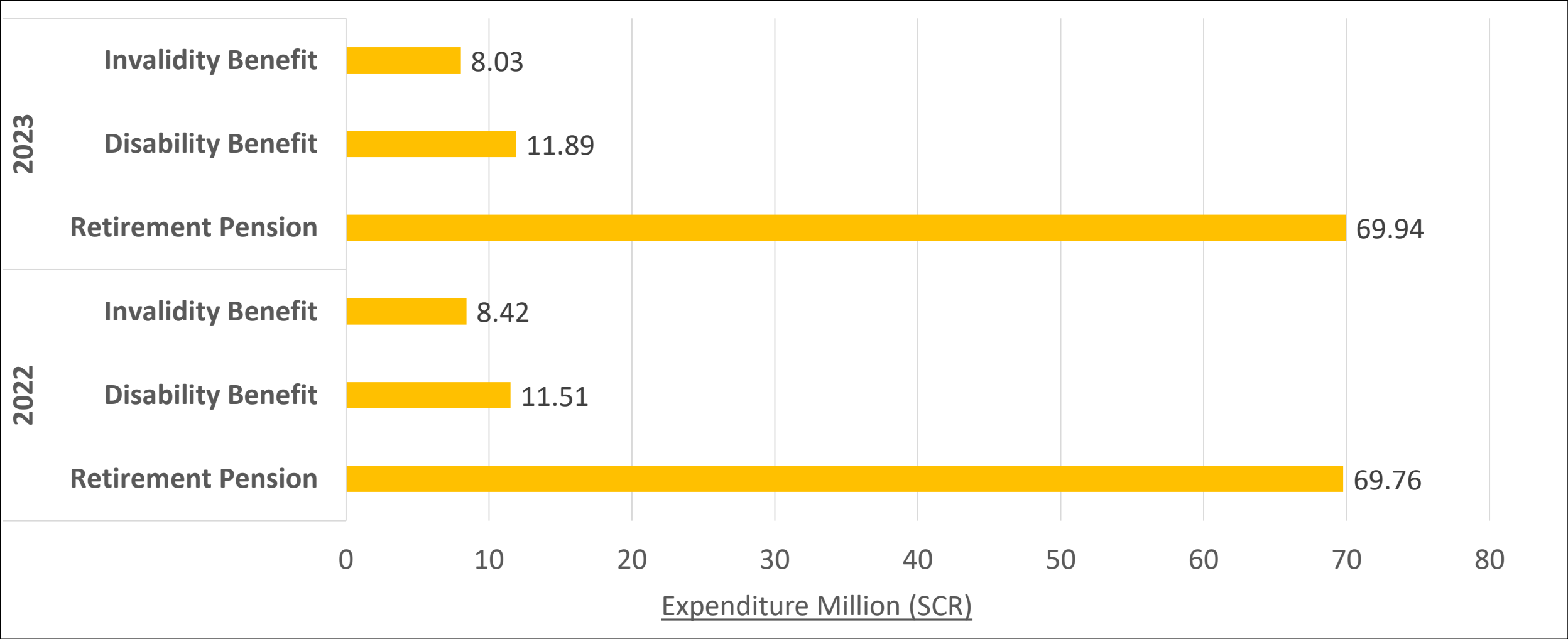
